Allons-nous amuser au musée en français !



As well as the online program, *Apprendre et Réfléchir avec les petites bêtes*, the following **staff led excursion programs** are available at the museum:

Découvrir en français: (Years 1-6): A highly interactive programme in French. Children become scientists when they examine real bugs [in resin] in order to discover the reasons behind various classifications as well as observing 'Loulou' [a live insect] up close. The environmental impact of bugs is also covered.

La biodiversité fragile: (Years 7-9): An interactive and informative introduction to the world of 'les petites bêtes' and their importance to ecosystems and biodiversity. Students observe male/female bugs and discover the reasons for visible differences; examine various defence systems of animals and bugs; discover the meaning of biodiversity and ecology. The session is conducted in French.

These staff led programs are conducted in French by a qualified French teacher and supported by the AFTV. Teachers who are members of the AFTV will have the students' costs waived; however, a booking fee of \$11 per school group will apply. Code for members is AFTVMV.

All education groups visiting the museum for a staff led OR self-guided excursion need to book in advance to ensure access to programs and exhibitions.
