Toorak Primary School was opened in 1890 consisting of a single, original red brick building. Over the years, the buildings and grounds at Toorak Primary School have been fully refurbished to provide an attractive, functional learning environment for all students. Wider community members also utilise the array of facilities on offer at Toorak Primary School. The school is a Foundation to Year 6 primary school located in the inner city of Toorak, 5 kilometres south-east of the Melbourne CBD, and has the advantage of opening onto Brookville Gardens. We strive for a culture of excellence for all students within a caring, nurturing, and inclusive community.

Our inner-city school has an enrolment of approximately 480 students with 22 classes. Four specialist classes including French, Physical Education, Music and Visual and Performing Arts are offered to all students throughout the year. Other languages available at Toorak Primary School include German and Swedish through external providers. Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics (STEAM) learning opportunities are integrated across the curriculum. As part of the Performing and Visual Arts Programs, a school production is staged every second year with a musical production, alternating with a school Art Show. The school has commenced the Science of Reading journey and is currently building teacher knowledge and capacity to implement change in classroom practices. In line with the State Government initiative, "Building the Education State", Toorak Primary School supports the Victorian Curriculum. Single levels operate across the school from foundation through to grade 6 where possible.

- SC5 Demonstrated behaviours and attitudes consistent with Department values. Demonstrated experience in reflecting upon practice and engaging in professional learning to continually improve the quality of teaching.
- SC6 Demonstrated knowledge and/or experience in teaching French to ensure that all students achieve a level of competency in the French language.
